ALREADY PERMANENTLY RESIDENT IN EUROPE: WOMEN
AND MEN WHO LIVE IN OUR CITIES AND SUBURBS, WHO
HAVE CHILDREN IN OUR SCHOOLS AND WHO NEED TO
COMMUNICATE IN THE MOST COMMON SITUATIONS OF
EVERYDAYLIFEBUTARE UNABLE TO DO SO BECAUSE THEY
DON'T SPEAK OUR LANGUAGE AND HAVE BECOME
"INVISIBLE" TO THE SYSTEM.

THE BRIDGE PROJECT IS ADDRESSED TO THEM, THROUGH INFORMAL LANGUAGE TEACHING METHODS BASED ON A "LANGUAGE CLUB" MODEL. 
